ABOUT THE MEETING

EFOR NETWORK (Network of Functional Studies in Model Organisms) aims to bring together a network of scientific experts to share knowledge and build a complete database on model organisms commonly used in research.

As part of the development of this network, EFOR holds an annual meeting for researchers who specialize in the study of a particular model organization to share the progress of their research work.

CELPHEDIA (Creation, Breeding, Phenotyping, Distribution and Archiving of model organisms) is a national and operational research infrastructure distributed over the French territory, aiming to develop innovative, standardized and massively parallel technological approaches, in order to accelerate the understanding of the genome and the generation of human or animal disease models.

CELPHEDIA-TEFOR as part of the CELPHEDIA infrastructure, supports research on two non-mammalian model species, zebrafish and fruitfly, by providing services to public and private research on easily accessible resources in genome editing, transgenesis, mutagenesis, and phenotyping by imaging.

The 3Rs Meeting focus on the Replace, Refine and Reduce principles (3Rs) aimed at rationalizing and limiting the use of animals in scientific research. This event will be an opportunity to highlight innovations in alternative methods, ethical reflection on the use of animals for scientific purposes and their direct application in research work.


